Ticket Sales

For every \$5 ticket sold, you keep \$2.50.

Tips

Speak to your tables about tips. Tell your guests what you are raising money for.

Auction/Raffle

Bring items for a silent auction, or sell raffle tickets. Guests must not be present to win, and you'll need to contact winners after the event.

Placemats

Sell ad space to businesses and create place mats. You would work with your own designer and printer.

Donation Bucket

Have a donation bucket visible either at the entry door or have someone working the exit door.

How To Get Started...

Step 1: Select a date and get your tickets

We recommend Tuesdays or Thursdays. Pancake suppers are from 5-7pm. You would need to schedule your pancake supper at least 30 days in advance to allow plenty of time to sell tickets.

Then what?

Step 2: Sell tickets & advertise

We will print your tickets and either mail them to you or have them ready to pick up at Flapjack's. We will provide you with 500 tickets. There is a 200 ticket minimum. Please be sure that your group sells at least 200 tickets. 7 days in advance, please give an estimate on the number of tickets sold.

Step 3: Pancake Supper

Please arrive one hour prior to your event. After you assign roles for your group, a manager will train your team.

Payment will need to be made that night. For each \$5 ticket, you keep half and we keep half. We will charge for a minimum of 200 people @ \$2.50 = \$500. After your minimum of 200 tickets, we only charge for the people that show up.

If your group is tax exempt, we need a copy of your tax exempt form. The Tennessee Department of Revenue requires that tax exempt transactions be made with a check or credit card from your organization. You will need to have one of those payment methods that night. The name on the tax exempt form must match the name on the check or credit card. If you choose to pay with cash or a personal credit card, we must charge sales tax.

After your event you will have the remainder of your ticket money, tips, and any additional funds you have raised!
